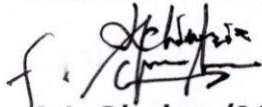

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UPDATE OF COUNCIL'S OFFICIAL WEBSITE ON INLAND DRY PORTS (IDPs) AND VEHICLE TRANSIT AREAS (VTAs) PROJECTS.

1. **DALA INLAND DRY PORT KANO STATE:** Having attained practical level of completion, Dala IDP has been commissioned by His Excellency, the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria Muhammadu Buhari, GCFR on 30th January, 2023.
2. **FUNTUA INLAND DRY PORT KATSINA STATE:** Following the attainment of the minimum standard level of completion, Funta IDP was declared as a Port of Origin and Destination for import/ export cargoes by the Honourable Minister of Transportation on 2nd February, 2023.
3. **JOS INLAND DRY PORT PLATEAU STATE:** As a result of the smooth exit of Duncan Maritime Ventures, Ltd, and the successful takeover of the Jos IDP by Plateau State Investment and Property Company Limited (PIPC), the new concessionaire has returned to site.
4. **LEGACY IDPs:** The under listed transport infrastructures are also in the process of development, viz,
 - i. The Legacy IDPs: Ibadan, Aba, Maiduguri & Jos
 - ii. Ogun state (Kajola) IDP
 - iii. Osun state (Dagbolu) IDP
 - iv. Kebbi state (Lolo) IDP
 - v. Anambra state (Onitsha) IDP
 - vi. Delta state (Ogwashi Uku) IDP
